NOTES TO HELP YOU REGISTER

Proficiency Levels:

For maximum satisfaction, please use these guidelines when making your selections.

Beginner (BEG): You have limited experience in playing the chosen instrument.

Intermediate (INT): Your technique is solid and you are comfortable working at a faster pace to learn new tunes.

Upper Intermediate/Advanced: For VERY strong Intermediate and Advanced players. This level moves quickly.

Advanced (ADV): You may already perform publicly but are looking for new insights from a master in order to take your playing to the next level.

Note: Less experienced players are welcome to audit classes (watch and listen) if space is available. Players may participate if able to keep up with the pace set by the class. The price is the same whether playing or listening. All are encouraged to record classes as an aid to further practice.

Workshop/Demo Levels:

Workshop: Standard class *generally* geared toward the needs of the stated proficiency level.

“Introduction To” Workshop: Introductory workshop for Beginner students presented free of charge. Instruments are provided for Whistle and Bodhran classes.

Demonstration (DEMO): A themed talk and/or performance designed to inform and entertain musicians and non-musicians alike. Open to all.
